


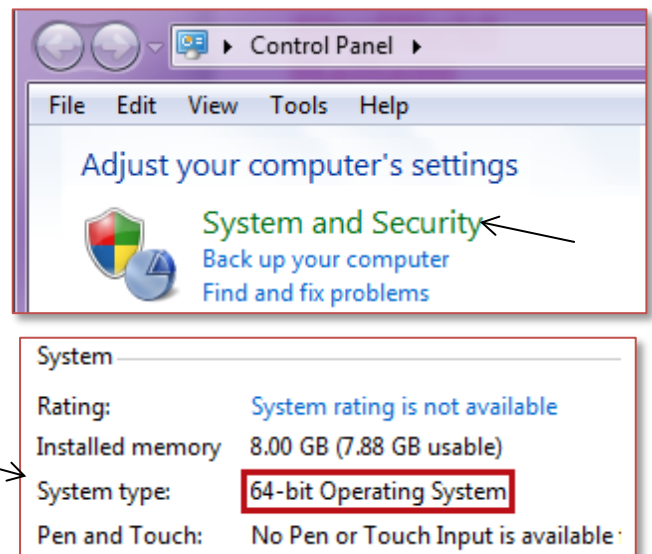
## 32-bit or 64-bit?

### Checking if your PC is running 32-bit or 64-bit operating system


*Some applications' installation processes can differ based on your operating system, Please use this guide to determine which you are running.*

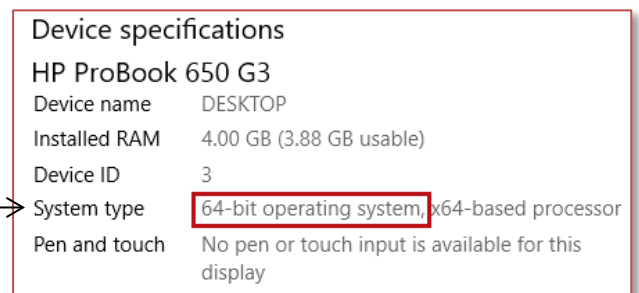
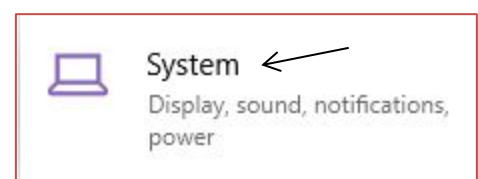
#### Windows 7 PC

1. Click the start menu button 
2. Click 'Control Panel'
3. Click 'System and Security'
4. Click 'System'
5. See section 'System' and the 'System type' should advise you of the operating system.



#### Windows 10 PC

1. Click the start menu button 
2. Click the cog icon (two icons above start)
3. Click 'System'
4. Scroll down on the menu to 'About' (last option)
5. See section 'Device specifications' and the 'System type' should advise you of the operating system.
