


Instructions


Accessing AppsAnywhere

Step	Instructions	Screenshot
1	Log into the Architecture desktop.	<p>Instructions on how to access the Windows Virtual Desktop client can be found in Appendix 1.</p> <p>On the remote desktop client, choose the 'Architecture' desktop.</p> 
2	Open the Start Menu.	
3	Click the 'AppsAnywhere' shortcut.	
4	The AppsAnywhere site will be opened in Internet Explorer.	
5	A green message should be displayed at the top of the screen when you have been validated.	
6	Use the search bar at the top right hand side of the web page to look for applications.

8	To launch an application, mouse over the appropriate tile and click 'Launch'.




<p>Sketchup Pro</p> <p>AppsAnywhere Tile:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - AppsAnywhere search term: Sketchup - On the first launch of Sketchup, choose the option to create a simple model. - When the model screen is displayed, click the 'Window' menu and open 'Preferences'  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Untick 'Use fast feedback' and press 'OK'. - Exit and relaunch sketchup.

Appendix 1 - Accessing Remote Desktop client.

These instructions are intended for use on a SHU Windows 10 managed desktop computer.

There is a pre-requisite that you will need to be connected to the SHU VPN in order to access this client.

Step	Description
1	<p>Open the Software Center.</p> <p>Start menu > Microsoft System Center > Software Center</p> 
2	Click 'Windows Desktop Client'
3	<p>On the next screen, click 'Install'</p> 
4	Following completion of the installation, the remote desktop client can be found in the start menu.



Open the client, at which point you will be prompted to subscribe to a workspace. Press 'Subscribe with URL' and enter



Press 'OK' on the next screen.

Double-click the desktop you wish to access.
