

Connecting to eduroam Wi-Fi (Windows 8)

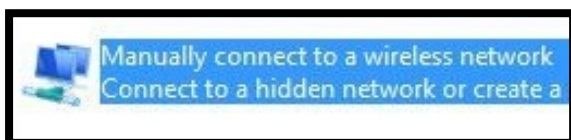
Right click the **Wi-Fi icon** in the system tray and select **Network and Sharing Center**.

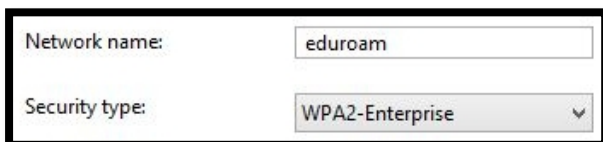
Click **Set up a new connection or network**

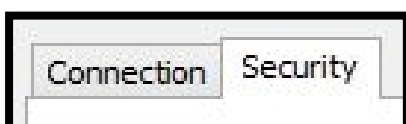
Fill in the **Network name** and **Security type** as shown.

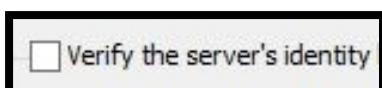
Click the **Security** tab

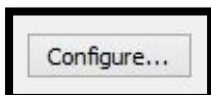

Un-tick **Verify the server's identity**

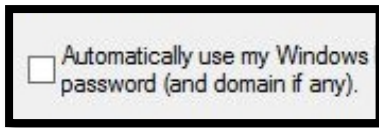

Click the "**Configure**" button.

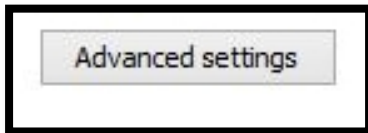

Click the "**Advanced settings**" button.

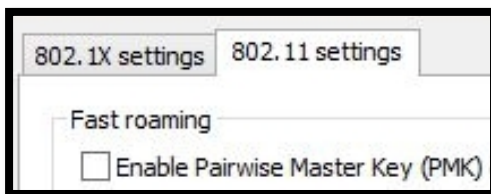

Select **User authentication**

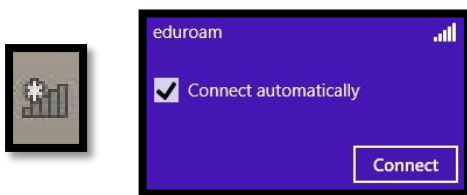

Click the **802.11** settings tab

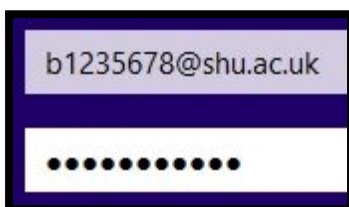
Untick **Enable Pairwise master key**
